About The Atlanta First UMC Organ

Our organ, the third such instrument to be installed in the 116 year history of this sanctuary, is a five manual, 159 rank pipe organ built in 2007 by the A. E. Schlueter Organ Company of Lithonia, Georgia. The organ has 5,360 pipes and the front case stands over 40 feet high. Two parts of the organ are located in the rear balcony of the sanctuary: the antiphonal, located in the side alcoves, and the magnificent En Chamade Trompette, located directly below the stained glass windows. The organ includes pipes from an 1885 organ that was originally installed in the previous church structure that housed Atlanta First (1870 to 1903), which was also the first organ to be installed in this sanctuary.
